YouTube

It has come to our attention that a number of our pupils have their own YouTube channel. The rules are that if anyone under the age of 18 does this, then they need parental consent. I would highly advise that you check the content of any content that your child posts online, including checking that the language they are using is appropriate.

In order to keep your child safe online, they should not divulge any personal information about themselves, including their age, their school or their address.

It appears that some of our children have posted this information about themselves and I am concerned that they are putting themselves at risk.

Children should also not have an account on social media if they are under the age of 13.
