Online behaviour

A small number of incidents have come to my attention, where some of our children have been involved in inappropriate behaviour when using on-line games or social media. I suggest that all parents check their child's behaviour on-line. If you find that your child is a victim of such behaviour, I suggest that you take a screen-shot and take the evidence to your local police station and log the abuse as a crime.

Parking

Traffic outside school has caused a number of problems this week.

- 1) A number of drivers have been allowing pedestrians, including children, to get in and out of their car on the yellow zig-zags or in the middle of the road.
- 2) Drivers have been parking on the solid yellow line during restricted times.
- 3) Drivers have parked their car at junctions of side streets, blocking routes where children need to cross.

These actions are against the law and put the safety of our children at risk. Before the holidays, there were two incidents where children were hit by cars, luckily, no injuries were sustained at these times, but I need you to have the safety of our children as your highest priority.

You should find a safe and legal place to park and then walk the few minutes to school.

Please ensure that your child is collected promptly at **4.15pm** after the club.

If you are late collecting them, then they may lose their place in the club.
