Dear Parents/Carers,

Pupil's use of technology

We always recommend that parents monitor their child's use of technology very closely. It has come to my attention that there is some horrific content being circulated on social media and on YouTube at the moment, which is causing great distress amongst children. The content of this material is a suicide game, which encourages children to self-harm or take their own lives.

I highly recommend that:

-Use of technology is monitored and that children under the age of 13 do not have access to the internet on any device, unless it is supervised by an adult

-Children are encouraged to report any concerning content to an adult, immediately

-Children under the age of 13 do not have social media accounts or access to YouTube.

-If someone contacts your child directly or abuses your child online, you should contact the Child Exploitation and Online Protection Agency (Just google CEOPS for more details).
