To provide home learning.	Teachers to provide a range of home learning for pupils. This can be accessed should any groups of children be required to work from home or if any parents want to do additional work at home with their child based on the week's learning.	Class teachers to provide weekly learning linked the programmes of study in the class.	Children have access to home learning that is sequential and progressive.



	To provide an overview of the upcoming learning for the class and to ensure that this is sent home, so that parents / carers can support children in their learning before and during their topics. Parents / carers to be encouraged to explore the vocabulary with their child and to research the meanings of words, especially if English is not their first language.		
To supplement weekly work with additional tasks.	Teachers to provide a range of supplementary tasks each week, to enhance the learning in class. To monitor the work carried out weekly by pupils and to provide additional support as necessary.	Class teachers.	Children and families can access additional work / activities should they wish to, to accelerate catch-up.
