metal	any solid mineral element that exhibits certain characteristics such as the ability to conduct heat or electricity	
plastic	an artificial substance made from certain kinds of chemicals that can be easily shaped when soft.	
glass	a hard, clear material that breaks easily	
brick	a hard block of dried or baked clay used as a building material	
rock	a solid mass made up of minerals. Rock forms much of the earth's outer layer, including cliffs and mountains	
paper	a thin material made from wood, rags, or grasses	
cardboard	a stiff material made of layers of paper	
squash	to press, beat, or crush into a flat mass	
bend	to take on a curved or angled form	
twist	to make into a coil or spiral	
stretch	to cause to become longer or wider
