






You can become a good speller by using these strategies...

<p>Look, say, cover, write, check</p>	
<p>Sound buttons</p>	<p>Split the word into its sounds. You can use sound buttons too. a dot for a sound with one letter and a line for a sound with 2 or more letters.</p> <p>beach      b   ea   ch</p>
<p>Quick-write</p>	 <p>How many times can you write it in 30 seconds?</p>
<p>Drawing an image around the word</p>	
<p>Rainbow writing</p>	<p>Rainbow writing. Using coloured pencils in different ways can help to make parts of words memorable.</p> <p>sure   sure   sure   sure   sure   sure   sure</p>
<p>Pyramid words Triangle words</p>	<p>Say the letter names out loud as you write them (or in your head).</p> 
<p>Clap the syllables</p>	 <p>Clap the syllables in a word.</p> <p>beau-ti-ful</p>
<p>Count the letters</p>	<p><b>b e a u t i f u l</b></p> <p>1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9</p>
<p>Boxing up</p>	<p>Draw boxes around the letters in a word or the whole word.</p>
