• Thank you to those who supported the Royal British Legion for Armistice Day on Monday. Mrs Hardman led an assembly for the children so that they could understand the significance.

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
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• A visitor from BFC came to work with Y3 to promote healthy drinks and the impact of fizzy

Our girls' football team with Mikayla Wildgoose and Naomi Hartley from Burnley FC Women's team.




#### **School Photographs**
