We will be celebrating World Book Day on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> March.

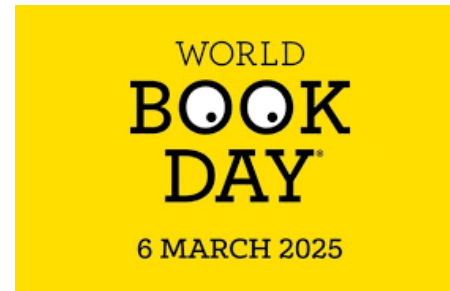
Children can come to school dressed as a character from a book.
