


Phonics / Reading

Maths

If your child is confident they could colour their own and glue the ones which match into their home learning books.

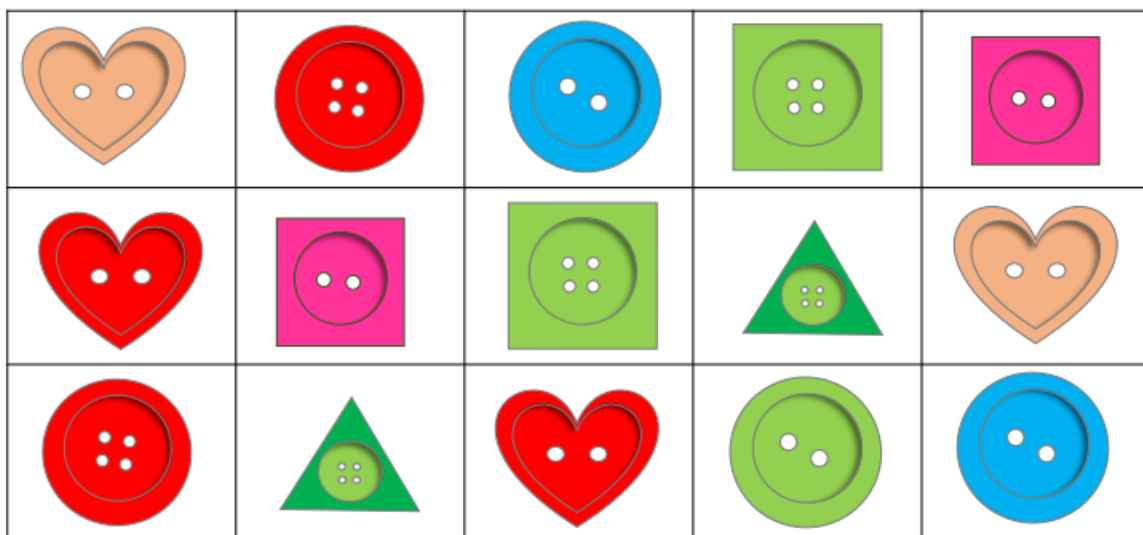

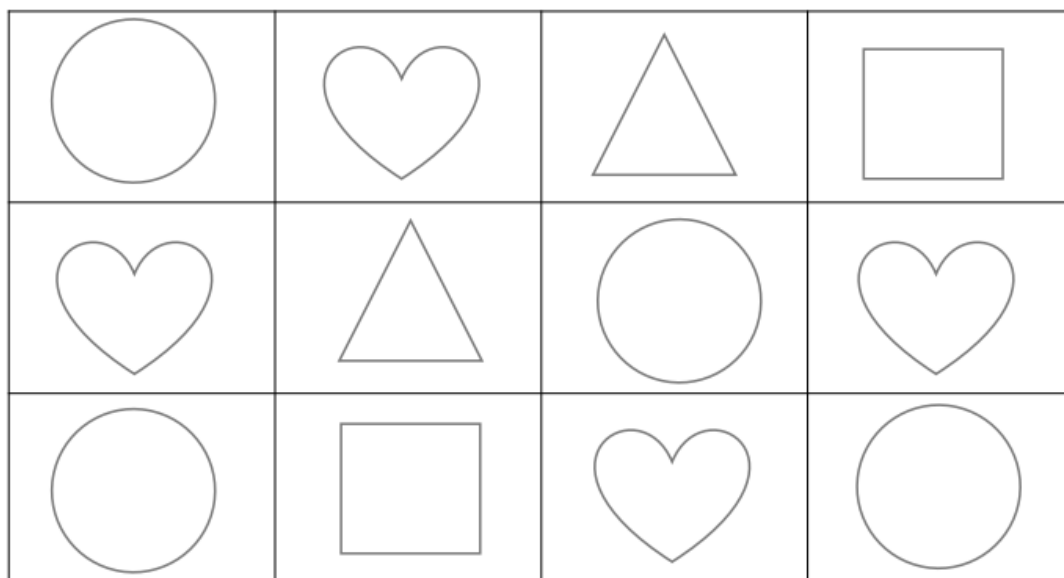
